It's hard to believe that the staff of the Catholic Community Foundation of Minnesota (CCF) has worked remotely for more than 18 months now. We've experienced profound changes since we last sat around our boardroom table together — as individuals, as a team, and as a community.

Although so much has changed externally, what drives us internally at CCF remains the same. I often call it our “secret sauce.” You can't see it, but it's what sets us apart: our mission and values. This part of our work — why and how we do it — is our living legacy.

And at CCF, we have the honor and privilege of helping carry out the legacies of our donors and partners through the power of endowment. When they entrust us with their physical treasure, we steward it in perpetuity to benefit the ministries and causes that best reflect their values.

And thanks to our donors and partners, CCF now stewards more than \$510 million in total assets. More importantly, we continue to grant \$17 million annually to the spiritual, educational, and social needs of our Catholic community. Since our founding, we've granted a total of \$207 million. And as we've adjusted to our growth, we've welcomed four new highly skilled, mission-driven professionals to the CCF team.

This is possible, in part, because of donors like Emery and Karen Koenig, who learned the value of generosity as children, and parishes like the Church of St. Timothy in Maple Lake, a pillar in its rural community for more than 100 years. And it's possible because of the humble leadership of groups like the League of Catholic Women, which will forever honor its legacy through perpetual grantmaking.

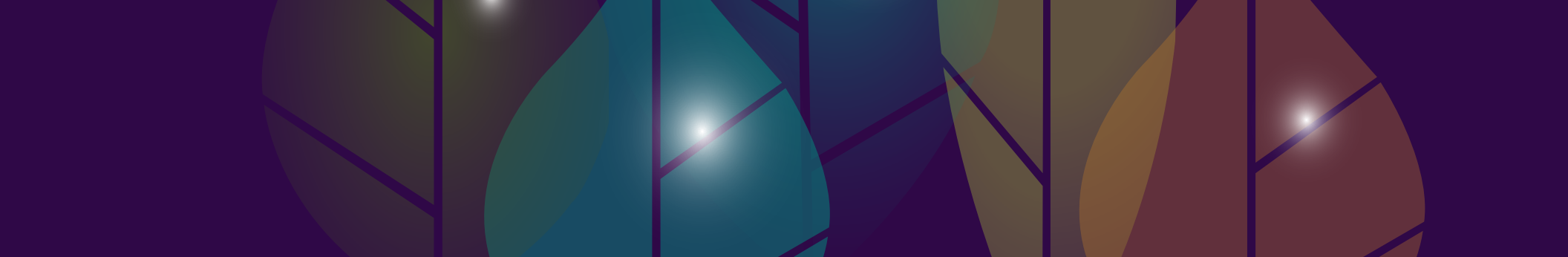

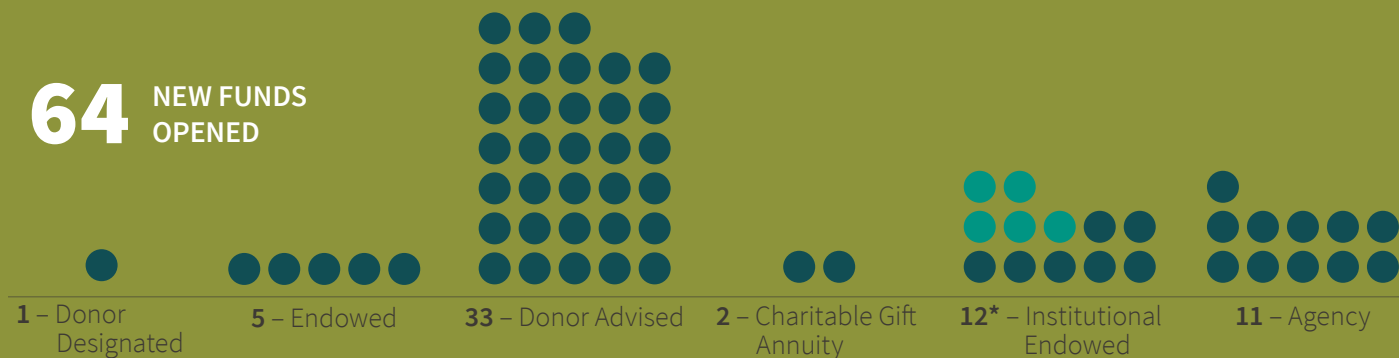

# an impact beyond their lifetime

## HOW THE KOENIGS PLAN TO FULFILL THEIR NEED TO GIVE — EVEN LONG AFTER THEY’RE GONE

As part of their estate plan, Emery and Karen (Bly) Koenig have chosen to establish a perpetual endowment at the Catholic Community Foundation of Minnesota (CCF). “We hope our gift will have an impact beyond our lifetime,” Emery says. “We really trust CCF for competency, integrity, and focus. There’s real peace of mind knowing the funds will always be managed in alignment with the teachings of the Church.”

### A PHILOSOPHY OF LIVING SIMPLY AND GIVING GENEROUSLY

Emery and Karen’s decision to make philanthropy part of their estate plan grew out of lessons in giving that began in childhood. Emery’s mother encouraged her children by handing out nickels every Sunday morning for them to drop into the collection box at Mass. “It became a need to give,” Emery says. Karen recalls the summer her father died in a farm accident when she was a teenager and how neighbors rallied to support the family. “Everyone came together and harvested everything for us,” she says. “It was a good introduction to how wonderful people can be.”

As newlyweds, Emery and Karen committed to tithing, which was a stretch for a young couple just starting out. Emery’s job at Cargill required them to move frequently, and wherever they landed, Karen would find a nursing job at the local hospital. They always strived to live simply, even after Emery was promoted to vice chairman and chief risk officer at Cargill. “We never needed the biggest house,” Emery says.

Emery and Karen focused on family instead. Their first two children, Kristina and John, were 8 and 6 years old, respectively, when Emery and Karen adopted 3-month-old Joseph from Peru, followed a year later by his sister, Catherine. Karen had to stay in Peru for long stretches as each adoption wound its way through the system. “I lived there for six months, and the kindness of those people will never leave me,” she says. “They had nothing, and they were giving to me.”

### A SENSE OF COMMUNITY

Emery and Karen opened a donor advised fund at CCF in 2006, and Emery joined the board of directors in 2011. As chair of the grants committee, Emery believes CCF’s ethos around grantmaking aligns with his own. “At CCF it’s more than just cutting checks. The staff gets to know the people. They seek feedback,” he says. “I’m lucky enough to have money to give. But whether someone’s giving or receiving, we are equal. We are all in community together.”

For Emery and Karen, who feel they’ve gotten far more than they’ve ever given, creating a charitable endowment at CCF is a natural choice. As Karen reflects on the people living 100 years from now who will benefit from the endowment, she has a message for them: “This comes from God, and God loves you.” ●

# a church of many generations

HOW A PARISH HOPES TO PRESERVE ITS PAST  
AND SECURE ITS FUTURE



The sugar maples on the shores of Maple Lake are interconnected by deep roots through which they share nutrients and protect the health of surrounding trees.

And for more than 100 years, the Church of St. Timothy has served much the same purpose for its community — spreading the love of Jesus Christ through the celebration of the sacraments and providing lifelong Christian formation.

The seeds of the parish were planted when Irish Catholic immigrants arrived in Maple Lake in the mid-1800s. Over the next 70 years, the faith community took root and grew. In 1922, overflowing their church, parishioners began to fundraise tirelessly for a new building. The next year, they celebrated their first Mass in the same building St. Timothy parishioners do today. In 1951 the parish branched out and opened a Catholic school.

“It’s an amazing parish,” says pastor Father John Meyer. “Life in Maple Lake still revolves around the church. It’s not only located in the center of town — it’s central to our parishioners’ lives.”

## BUILDING THE FUTURE

As the church approaches its 100th anniversary, the parish has looked toward the next 100 years — and how the community might ensure that its beloved church and school will endure.

With the goal of securing a consistent, stable source of income well into the future, parish leadership created the St. Timothy Legacy Program. Through two perpetual endowments — one for the parish and one for the school — parishioners can support their faith community not only today but forever.

After interviewing several investment organizations, parish leadership decided to entrust the endowment funds to the Catholic Community Foundation of Minnesota (CCF). The assurance that CCF would invest funds in alignment with their shared Catholic faith was a key factor in their decision.

“And CCF was a huge help at council meetings where otherwise we might have been spinning our wheels,” says Father Meyer. “They really understand parish life and culture.”

Legacy Program Co-Chair Greg Thomes knows from his professional experience in the insurance industry the value of planning for future needs. “I’ve only been a member of this parish for 40 years, which makes me something of a newcomer,” says Greg. “But I want to see this parish stay strong for the next 100 years.”

Angie Pribyl serves on St. Timothy’s finance committee and married into one of Maple Lake’s earliest families. “This beautiful legacy is something we want to pass on to our children,” says Angie, “just as it was passed on to us.”

Frank Sullivan’s children are seventh-generation St. Timothy parishioners. A member of the parish advisory council, Frank knows the reach of the parish extends beyond its community. “We want to preserve the faith and foundation that St. Timothy provides,” he says, “not only for the future of our families but for the future of the Catholic Church.” ●

For more than 100 years, the League of Catholic Women has empowered women by opening doors of opportunity to a hopeful future. Ever since its establishment in 1911, the League has run programs no one else would, helping women reach their fullest potential — even before women were granted the right to vote.

Bold, welcoming, and unwavering, the League has always operated independently of any parish or diocese. It provided stable housing for immigrants, served meals for seniors longing for connections, organized outreach for women with AIDS, ran group homes for at-risk youth, and outfitted women entering the workforce with professional clothing — always rising to the occasion to meet the greatest needs of the time.

Recently, the League embarked on a monumental transformation to ensure its long-standing legacy endures amid a changing landscape. It partnered with the Catholic Community Foundation of Minnesota (CCF) to establish a foundation and become a perpetual grantmaker, carrying forth the tradition set by its foremothers.

#### CHARTING A NEW PATH

Lisa Fitzgerald Miller originally joined the League in 1995. Her participation waned as she raised her four children. By the time she became more active again 15 years later, she recognized significant changes. The membership base was aging. Millennials entrenched in family life and careers had less interest in the membership model of volunteerism.

“Younger generations have their own way of giving back, and it’s different from what the League offered,” Lisa explains.

The members faced a crossroads. They saw the value of their expansive programs in the countless women and children impacted by their ministries. They held close to their deeply rooted relationships, strengthened by decades of serving side by side. No one wanted to walk away.

Rising League members knew that to effectively continue their charitable mission they needed to transform their model of impact and governance. The League sold its headquarters, a historic home in downtown Minneapolis, and began working out of The Woman’s Club nearby.

With funds from the sale, League members discussed how they could be the best stewards of their resources and carry out their mission in a different way.

Lisa, as newly elected board president, established a transition team and enlisted the help of Mimi Palen-Clare, president of Executive Growth Advisors, to navigate a pivotal discernment process. Together, they redefined the League’s vision and set a direction for a sustainable future.

“It was a difficult and painful, yet exciting, transition process,” says Mimi. “Members were grieving a part of the past that was changing while opening the door to an exciting future — and nobody anticipated how great the future could be.”

#### OPENING DOORS TO A GREAT FUTURE

Looking to connect with an organization that shares in its Catholic values, the League identified CCF as an ideal partner to execute its new vision. To fulfill the League’s intent to serve women in the community for years to come, CCF recommended establishing a foundation using an endowment to give grants to mission-aligned organizations and projects. Through an endowment, the League could distribute nearly \$100,000 to grantees — every single year in perpetuity.

League members were amazed at the possibilities for such an impactful legacy, but many were hesitant and emotional about dissolving a 100+-year-old membership organization.

Two members of CCF’s leadership team, Meg Payne Nelson and Christopher Nelson (no relation), met personally with League members to answer questions and address concerns. They reassured them that existing relationships and programs could — and should — continue.

“The second that somebody takes the time to do that, you know you’re in good hands,” Lisa says.

In 2020 an implementation group of League members and CCF representatives worked to create the new League of Catholic Women Foundation (LCWF). To keep League members involved and the mission entrenched in how funds were disbursed, CCF suggested establishing an advisory committee to identify annual grant recipients.

Through CCF’s broad network, the LCWF advisory committee has access to an even larger base of potential grantees whose work aligns with the League’s mission to empower women to build successful futures.

#### CARRYING ON THE SPIRIT OF SERVICE

The partnership between CCF and the League ensures this mission is carried out indefinitely. Through CCF’s stewardship, compassionate service, and Catholic identity, League members feel assured that the spirit of service and compassion established by the League’s foremothers more than a century ago will be honored forever.

“At the end of the day, doing good never changes,” Lisa says. “The way we do it may change, but CCF will see to it that our legacy will carry on forever.”

Former co-president Julie Ann Schmidt joined the League as a college student in the 1990s. She was drawn to the dynamic group of faithful women leading meaningful work in the Twin Cities.

After seeing more than \$98,000 awarded to 17 organizations in July 2021, she knows the League’s foremothers would be pleased.

“We’re a living foundation,” Julie Ann says. “We’re a living tradition of women doing great work.” ●
