

Dear Friends,

Hundreds of thousands of people from different economic, ethnic, and racial backgrounds make up our Catholic community. For all our individual differences, we so beautifully compose a single body: the Church. In unity with the faithful who have already passed, we form the communion of saints — a communion that joins us to Christ.

As I reflect on fiscal year 2022 at the Catholic Community Foundation of Minnesota (CCF), I see our philanthropic community, a communion of saints itself, proving through its actions that so much more can be accomplished as one united body.

Over the past year, despite continuing economic uncertainty, CCF’s philanthropic community carried on without wavering in passing on blessings received. Our donors and partners opened a record 88 new funds and gifted more than \$77 million. More importantly, cumulative grants from CCF funds totaled \$18.6 million in community and ministry impact.

One-third of the grants facilitated by CCF were from perpetual endowments. These funds, which will yield grants forever, connect us with those who have come before us. In this report, you’ll meet a daughter who must carefully consider her parents’ wishes and values as she now oversees their endowment fund.

Endowment funds also give us the chance to establish relationships with generations yet to come. We share the stories of two archdiocesan priests and the steps they took during their lives to ensure their ministries would carry on after their passing. We also share the story of a parish whose members have planned for endowment distributions to help build a more hopeful future for its neighborhood.

Through philanthropy, we can recognize and empower the members of our community who are often forgotten or purposely ignored. The final story in this annual report provides a glimpse at three grants CCF made last year to support our brothers and sisters on the margins.

It is my great honor to witness this communion of saints working to build God’s kingdom on Earth. Thank you for the role you play in this work and for your support of CCF’s mission through your engagement.

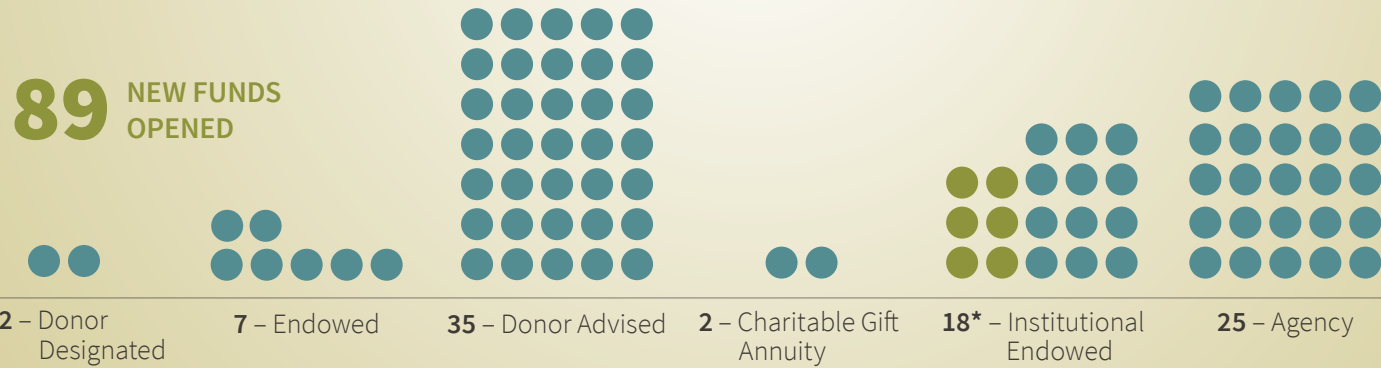

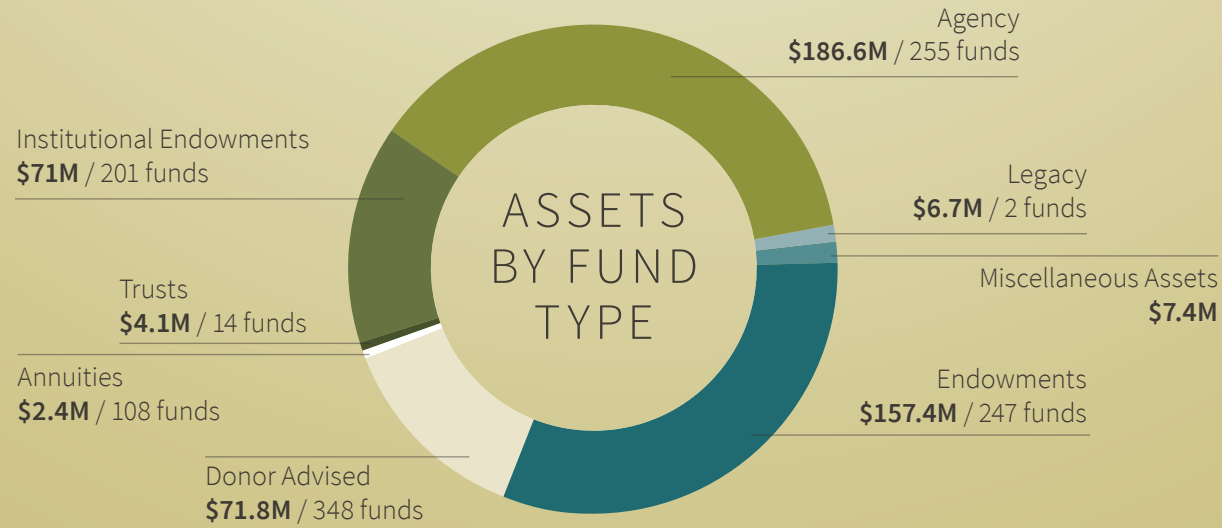

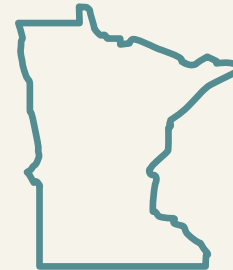

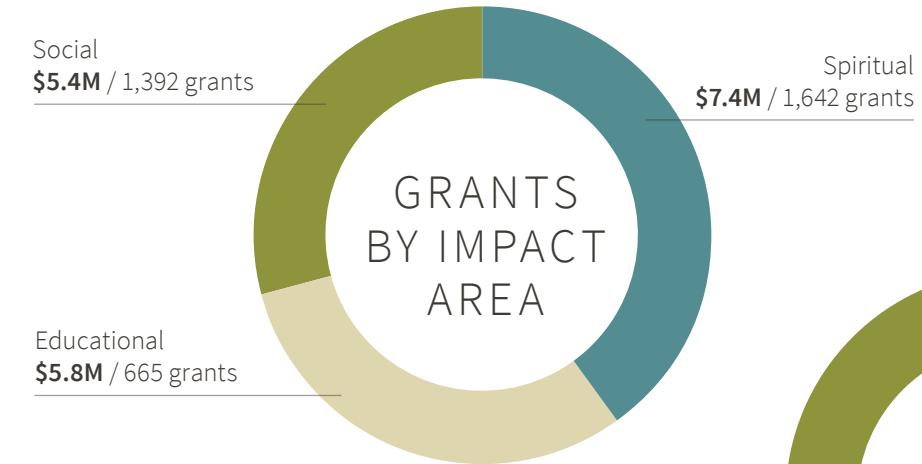

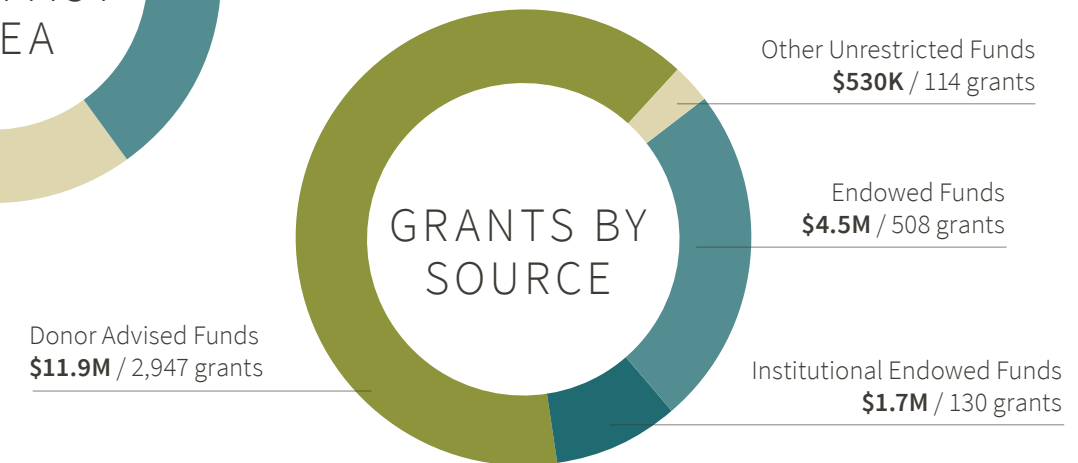

Family Foundation Celebrates God’s Gifts

For decades, Art and Joanne Popehn’s family foundation at the Catholic Community Foundation of Minnesota (CCF) has represented the culmination of a deeply held belief. “My father started with nothing and became very successful, but he never took pride in having earned what he got,” explains Peggy (Popehn) Carlson. “In his view, it all came from God. That’s why my parents wanted to make sure it all goes back to the Catholic community.”

Peggy’s parents met as choir members at St. Helena Catholic Church in Minneapolis. Art, who was a few years older than Joanne, had already served in World War II as a Navy aviator and then worked his way through Dunwoody College of Technology, where he showed a talent for engineering. After the couple married in 1948, Art would come home from his day job and spend his evenings working in the basement of their Minneapolis apartment, where he had set up a tool and die shop. He eventually transformed the basement business into his own manufacturing company.

While Art ran the business, Joanne ran the household and took care of their four children.

“She was a sweetheart,” Peggy says of her mother. “We had a very loving childhood. My dad made sure we toed the line, but my mom was a softie.”

GIVING BACK TO THE FAITH

Peggy joined her parents as an advisor to the family foundation a few years before her mother’s death in 2016. After that, Peggy’s husband, Steve Carlson, also became an advisor. Steve regularly drove his father-

in-law to appointments at the Minneapolis VA Medical Center, which provided them a lot of time together. Steve says, “He would often tell me, ‘Everything I’ve got is a gift from God, and when I leave this Earth, I will give it back to him.’”

Art passed away in 2021, three months shy of his 102nd birthday. By then, Peggy and Steve had already taken on full responsibility for overseeing the foundation’s distribution of funds.

GROWING THE CHURCH AND HELPING THE POOR

As the Carlsons make decisions about grant distributions, they observe the guidelines Art set for the foundation — to help the Church flourish and grow and to support charities that provide vocational training. Giving is also influenced by Art’s experience as a child during the Great Depression. “My father grew up very poor, and that made a strong impact on him,” says Peggy. “With the foundation, one of his wishes was always to help the poorest of the poor.”

The Carlsons’ role as advisors has been highly satisfying but not without challenges. “The hardest part is deciding — who do we give to?” says Peggy. “The world is always changing, and there are always new groups to fund. We want to be open to change while staying true to the original vision.”

Eventually the Carlsons hope to pass responsibility for the foundation to the next generation, but for now they value the opportunity it provides to help others. “For me,” Peggy says, “the best part has been carrying out my parents’ legacy and their passion for giving.” ●

Philanthropy Perpetuates Priestly Ministries

TURNING TO CCF TO CARRY OUT THEIR LEGACIES

Most philanthropists are not prominent public figures or top-ranking executives. In fact, they often wear a clerical collar.

Members of the clergy frequently include charitable giving as part of their personal faith journey. Some priests even choose to perpetually extend their ministries of faith-filled service through the power of endowment.

Two examples of priestly philanthropy in the Archdiocese of Saint Paul and Minneapolis can be found in Fathers James Himmelsbach and William Paron. They each turned to the Catholic Community Foundation of Minnesota (CCF) for prudent, faith-aligned stewardship of their charitable gifts. Today, those gifts — and the memories of these beloved priests — continue to impact our community.

A RETIRED MILITARY CHAPLAIN’S LEGACY ENDURES

While serving in the Vietnam War, James Himmelsbach met military chaplain Father Martin Fleming. Their relationship proved providential. James followed in Father Fleming’s footsteps by becoming a priest in 1977, working as a military chaplain, and eventually partnering with CCF to facilitate his charitable giving.

Father Himmelsbach served all over the world during his 21-year career as an Army chaplain. He often invited his friend Father Michael Skluzacek to join him.

Father Himmelsbach truly cared for and served the soldiers, Father Skluzacek says. He would celebrate Mass at up to five different sites in one day — sometimes from the bumper of an Army Jeep.

“As a chaplain, you’re often moving to a new site, and he was really good at getting to know people and forming connections,” Father Skluzacek says.

Their travels to South Korea, Hawaii, and numerous U.S. military forts took them far from Welch Village, where then fourth-year Deacon Himmelsbach, a certified ski instructor, taught first-year seminarian Skluzacek how to

ski. They formed a friendship that would last 45 years and include annual kayaking trips to the Boundary Waters Canoe Area in northern Minnesota.

After retiring from the Army as a lieutenant colonel in 2001, Father Himmelsbach served as pastor of St. Joseph Catholic Community in Waconia and the Church of the Annunciation in Minneapolis.

Father Lawrence Blake became the parochial administrator at St. Joseph following Father Himmelsbach’s pastorship. Father Blake recalls how Father Himmelsbach’s strong leadership fueled a successful capital campaign that helped sustain the parish’s newly opened Catholic school and demonstrated to him the powerful impact of lasting gifts.

Father Himmelsbach established a donor advised fund with CCF that converted to a perpetual endowment upon his death on Ash Wednesday in 2021. He also made estate gifts to the fund.

While Father Himmelsbach was private about finances, Father Skluzacek, who was at his friend’s bedside the day before he died, knew that he wanted to leave a legacy for Catholic education and the poor.

Father Skluzacek notes, “He saw Catholic education as being very instrumental in forming the character of young people.”

A BELOVED PRIEST LIVED SIMPLY AND GAVE GREATLY

Father William Paron knew how to live simply, foster relationships with others, and empower parishioners. He established that legacy during his 39 years of priestly ministry, which extended into his retirement in Waconia.

School Sister of Notre Dame Esther Wagner met Father Paron when he served at the Church of the Epiphany in Coon Rapids from 1974 to 1982. She remembers how he worked to involve parishioners and immersed himself in budgets to bring parish finances into good order.

“The people really appreciated his leadership,” Sister Esther says. “He planned so well, whether it was for the school or parish.”

Jim Cappelleri worked with Father Paron on the finance council at the Church of the Epiphany and later became his financial advisor and good friend.

“He was — not only in his finances, but in his whole life — very clear and intentional about what he did with his time,” says Jim.

When Father Paron was assigned as pastor at St. Wenceslaus Church in New Prague, Jim helped him form connections to spearhead a large capital campaign for school improvements and establish a fund at CCF, which was later endowed to perpetually support the parish and school ministries. That positive experience led Father Paron to establish his own endowment fund with CCF in 2011, benefiting the School Sisters of Notre Dame and Catholic Relief Services.

“He had this idea to touch the lives of people in a broader way that he could not do by himself,” says Sister Esther, noting Father Paron’s passion for genealogy and the global Church.

After serving at St. Nicholas Catholic Church in Carver, Father Paron retired in 2008. Even so, he continued to generously serve others. He regularly celebrated Mass at nearby parishes and senior homes and ministered to the sick, poor, and homebound.

Father Stan Mader, pastor at St. Joseph in Waconia, remembers Father Paron as a generous man whose approach to philanthropy embodied how he and other priests consider their legacies.

“How do we want the work of the Church to continue?” muses Father Mader, who established a donor advised fund with CCF in 1990. “Planned giving is a good way to continue the work that we’re a part of.” ●

A donor advised fund is a simple, flexible account that allows you to make gifts, receive immediate tax benefits, and then recommend grants on your own timeline. Donor advised funds can be used to plan giving annually and throughout your lifetime.

Endowment Extends Outreach to *Northside* Neighbors

For more than 100 years, St. Bridget Catholic Church has strived to fulfill its mission to be the welcoming presence of Christ on the north side of Minneapolis. Recently, parish members took steps to carry on that mission for the next 100 years. Income from the newly established St. Bridget Endowment Fund at the Catholic Community Foundation of Minnesota (CCF) will provide the financial stability needed to ensure St. Bridget's ministry and community outreach continue on in perpetuity.

Deacon Rich Heineman, who grew up in the parish and has served as its deacon since 2002, points out that while the neighborhood has changed over the years, St. Bridget's commitment to its neighbors hasn't. "The majority of people in the neighborhood are no longer Catholic, but they are good people," says Deacon Rich. "The endowment allows us to use our resources for the betterment of our community."

LEVERAGING RESOURCES TO GROW THE PARISH

The parish has begun to discern how income from the endowment earmarked for community outreach should be used. One idea is to partner with other Northside nonprofits. St. Bridget already has working relationships with several community organizations, including EMERGE, a nonprofit that provides skill-building, employment, and economic opportunities for Northside residents. The parish also supports Sojourner Truth Academy, a K-8 charter school located on the parish campus, and Hamilton Manor, a nearby public housing high-rise for older adults.

In 1997, as a new resident in North Minneapolis, Jennifer Kaplan joined St. Bridget after being bowled over by the welcome she received as a visitor.

Now a parish trustee, she thinks outreach funded by the endowment will raise St. Bridget's profile in the community, which will translate into new members. "I really believe that the more we as a parish get out in the community, the more people will want to join us," Jennifer says. "We want everyone on the Northside to feel like they are welcome here."

TAKING THE CHURCH INTO THE COMMUNITY

St. Bridget had already established the endowment when Father Marcel Okwara became parochial administrator last summer, but Father Okwara has been impressed by the parishioners' intentional approach as they consider how to steward the funds. "This is a call," he says. "By taking the Church outside of the building, we are fulfilling the mission of the Church. We don't want to just talk about serving Christ. We want to live it out."

Deacon Rich believes carrying out the mission of St. Bridget has the potential to build a more unified Northside community. "The membership of our parish is mostly white in an area where that's not the dominant culture," explains Deacon Rich. "There are language barriers and economic barriers, but none of them are insurmountable — as long as we let God lead us."

As parish leaders decide how to best steward the resources of the parish, they seek to balance St. Bridget's rich history with their plans for the future. "We have wonderful traditions, and we're open to new ideas," Jennifer says. "The endowment has energized people to reach out to other communities and be open to something new." ●

Love of neighbor is not bounded in any way. We are called to invest in the well-being of all those in need, because every person is a beloved member of God’s kingdom. This year the Catholic Community Foundation of Minnesota (CCF) had discretion over \$1.4 million in grants. Each grant aimed to support the spiritual, educational, or social needs of our community, focusing especially on investments in under-resourced communities.

FREEDOM TO STAND

As a spiritual home for Black Catholics in the Archdiocese of Saint Paul and Minneapolis, the Church of St. Peter Claver in Saint Paul attracts worshippers from across the metro area. The parish’s broad reach, however, makes stability a challenge.

“The natural charism of Black culture for hospitality helps, but generally we schedule programming on weekends, when our parishioners are already here,” says Father Joseph Gifford, the parish’s pastor. “Communication is a challenge, as is stewardship. In the past we have relied on one-time gifts and grants. How can we take the next step toward a more sustainable model?”

An anonymous benefactor working with CCF recognized the need for a concerted push.

“There are few primarily Black parishes in our archdiocese, and we want to see them flourish,” says the donor. “If we’re serious about Black Lives Matter, we need more than lawn signs. We need real support.”



Inspired by the donor, CCF provided its own grant toward this effort and enlisted archdiocesan support. Through the Emil and Julia Wittman Memorial Fund, from which the Archbishop makes annual grants, the Archbishop invested in the initiative. Through this collaborative effort and with its own contribution, the parish created a new position — director of communications and stewardship — to strengthen community and engagement. Grant support will decrease as the position becomes self-sustaining.

“The universality of the Catholic Church is spoken when donors support a community like Peter Claver,” says Mike Essien, a parish trustee. “Kudos to CCF for seeing that. We thank them sincerely for helping us walk this journey forward.”

STRENGTH IN DIVERSITY

In a lush corner of Maplewood, St. Jerome School nurtures souls. Principal Anne Gattman and her staff have made it their mission to provide a classical Catholic education to culturally diverse students.

“We have 90 percent students of color, and most fall well below the poverty line,” she says. “We serve a large number of Karen refugees from Myanmar (formerly Burma), as well as Hmong and African families.”

Diversity poses real challenges, Anne says, including financially supporting a school that serves families in need, welcoming people from different cultures and experiences, and teaching students who may not speak the same language. So, when CCF brought the Latino Enrollment Institute (LEI) to the archdiocese to help Catholic schools better serve

Latino families, St. Jerome staff members were quick to sign up, knowing they had yet to begin recruiting and serving this portion of their community in earnest.

“The LEI motivated us to find Latino Catholics in our community, but it also shared ideas for working with communities of different cultures like those we already serve,” Anne says.

“Latino families are our fastest-growing population, yet only 4 percent of this population is enrolled in Catholic schools,” says Katy Lichon, director of Catholic School Advantage at the University of Notre Dame. “We need to understand the imperative here.”

Katy and Anne agree that learning any second language is a strength and recruiting Latino families is additive.

“Once families trust that you have their best interests in mind, gifts are multiplied,” says Katy. “I commend CCF for knowing the need and helping local churches and schools make changes in their own space.”

DIGNITY IN THE FACE OF CHALLENGES

Every night, nearly 5,000 Minnesota youth need a place to sleep. Most are people of color, and many struggle with mental health issues.

Hope Street for Youth provides a haven and remedy for youth ages 18 to 24 experiencing homelessness. A ministry of Catholic Charities of St. Paul and Minneapolis, the emergency shelter offers a safe space for up to 30 residents at a time. Most transition to permanent housing in less than 40 days.

According to Molly McInerny, senior program manager, Hope Street’s clientele challenge typical notions of homelessness.

“This demographic is very busy working, going to school, and socializing. Some work full-time jobs plus overtime,” she says. “Most people have somewhere to stay while they save money for housing. These young people don’t have that.”

This spring, CCF partnered with Catholic Charities and local governments to move Hope Street from the St. Joseph’s Home for Children campus to a former assisted living facility in the Hiawatha neighborhood of Minneapolis. The \$6 million facility offers dignified private rooms, housing-focused case management, and more. The new shelter opened in June.

“People in the neighborhood had questions initially, but they ultimately said, ‘We want this program in our neighborhood,’” says Keith Kozerski, chief program officer. “The city, county, and partners like CCF came forward with very generous contributions. We have not seen this level of support, this easily, for many other programs.”

“It’s about promoting the common good for all people and practicing the words of Jesus Christ,” says Michael Goar, president and CEO of Catholic Charities of St. Paul and Minneapolis. “The mission of the Church lines up with the interests of our partners.

This is an investment strategy for CCF and our government partners. Without these resources, the new Hope Street wouldn’t exist.” ●
