


A FOUNDING OPPORTUNITY

In the early days of his priesthood, John Paul II, then Fr. Karol Wojtyla, would lead groups of young people on retreats in the wilderness where they would celebrate Mass, kayak, pray, read and sing songs around a campfire.

The same energy that inspired JPII to take young people out of their ordinary lives to experience our Lord in the context of His grand creation, drives us.

Our goal is to create a safe, fun, supportive environment where young people can have a life-changing encounter with Jesus.

During the summer, we will offer young people a best-in-class faith camp experience. The rest of the year, the camp will benefit the Archdiocese of Minneapolis-St. Paul with a large, well-equipped facility to host retreats and science camps for youth and adults.

THE NEED

For more than 2000 years, the Catholic Church has been the cornerstone of billions of people's lives. But as our society changes and the world becomes more secularized, the Church continues to grapple with the ever-changing belief systems of our youth. Social media, overt materialism, and addictive technology all further impact our youth in tragic ways. This has become even more evident in the mental health crisis that is gripping

our world. According to a recent study conducted by the Center for Disease Control and Prevention, 57% of teen girls in the US felt "persistently sad or hopeless" in 2021. The rate of suicide among young people is startling as more teens have thought about or attempted suicide than ever before. Our kids are struggling and these sobering trends reveal that the very lives of young people are on the line.

WHAT WE CAN DO ABOUT IT

We want to offer area youth a transformative encounter with Jesus Christ and build a legacy for our children and grandchildren. To do this, we need to give our children time away from technology and time to experience a beautiful natural environment where they feel safe, accepted, and encouraged. Here, they can meet other teens in a small group setting and be mentored by trained counselors who can make an impact in a way that can't be replicated elsewhere.



SUMMER CAMP

At our camp, youth will pray, hear talks challenging them to respond to God's calling, see skits that inspire, sing inspirational songs, spend time before the Blessed Sacrament and feel God's grace through the sacraments of Reconciliation and the Holy Mass, and learn to reflect on their experience in small groups with their peers.

To round out the camp experience, the campers will engage in high-adventure activities that not only enhance the joy in the experience, but also provide more opportunities to encounter God by testing their limits, surrounded by natural beauty. High ropes, archery tag and water activities all help youth embrace the camp environment, break down "walls" and build trust among the youth, counselors, and each other.

Combining a wealth of faith and fun opportunities helps young people experience the authentic love, joy and laughter that is central to our Catholic Faith.

In addition to summer camp, this space will be used for confirmation retreats, youth groups, and the Faith & Science retreats required by all Diocesan schools, adult silent retreats and much more.

Camp will offer daily Mass, daily talks pertaining to the theme of the week, Adoration, opportunities for confession, lake time and the chance to enjoy the natural beauty that surrounds the camp through the many engaging activities listed here.

- Low ropes/team building
- Giant swing
- Zip lining
- Frisbee golf
- Wiffle ball field

We currently have a purchase agreement in place for a property relatively close to the Twin Cities that meets almost all of our requirements to offer the best experience to the youth who would come: natural beauty, plenty of space for activities, adequate housing and large gathering spaces.

By purchasing and renovating this property, our capacity would more than double, allowing us to open our grounds to over 2,500 boys and girls each summer, not to mention the hundreds of others who would use the camp throughout the year. What's more as owners, we would have the ability to create an environment that is perfectly suited to their needs.

This would fill a major need for the ministries like Extreme Faith Camp, NET Ministries, and others whom we have heard directly from about the struggle to find adequate facilities.

We are seeking \$10 Million to cover the purchase of the property and enhancements.

We have seen the rich tradition of summer camp experiences in our Diocese. This location will become the go-to destination for ministries seeking to address the challenges young people face and to allow them to encounter Christ.

There are over 720,000 Catholics living in the Minneapolis-St. Paul area. We believe this project directly addressed one of the three key focus areas that came out of the recent synod conducted by our Archdiocese.
